UBBI shall provide the resources for religious education and strive for the spiritual growth of each student, for the aim of the Word of God being propagated throughout the country of Thailand.

Doctrinal Statement

1. We believe that love one for another as Jesus loves the believer manifests our discipleship, proves our love for God and symbolizes our authority as New Testament churches. Love is therefore the great commandment of the LORD Jesus Christ upon which all others are dependent (Matt. 22:35-40; John 13:34, 35; John 15:12; 1 John 4:7-21; 1 John 5:1-3; Rev. 2:4, 5).
2. We believe in the infallible, verbal inspiration of the whole Bible and that the Bible is the all-sufficient rule of faith and practice (Psalm 119:160; 2 Tim. 3:16, 17).
3. We believe in the personal triune God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, equal in divine perfection (Matt. 28:19).
4. We believe in the Genesis account of Creation (Gen. 1; 2).
5. We believe that Satan is a fallen angel, the archenemy of God and man, the unholy god of this world, and that his destiny is the eternal lake of fire (Isa. 14:12-15; Ezek. 28:11-19; Matt. 25:41; 2 Cor. 4:4; Eph. 6:10-17; Rev. 20:10).
6. We believe in the virgin birth and sinless humanity of Jesus Christ (Matt. 1:18-20; 2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Peter 2:22).
7. We believe in the deity of Jesus Christ (John 10:30; John 1:1, 14; 2 Cor. 5:19).
8. We believe the Holy Spirit is the divine Administrator for Jesus Christ in His churches (Luke 24:49; John 14:16, 17; Acts 1:4, 5, 8; Acts 2:1-4).

9. We believe that miraculous spiritual manifestation gifts were done away when the Bible was completed. Faith, Hope and Love are the vital abiding Spiritual Gifts (1 Cor. chapters 12-14).

10. We believe that Man was created in the image of God and lived in innocency until he fell by voluntary transgression from his sinless state, the result being that all mankind are sinners (Gen. 1:26; Gen. 3:6-24; Rom. 5:12, 19).

11. We believe that the suffering and death of Jesus Christ was substitutionary for all mankind and is efficacious only to those who believe (Isa. 53:6; Heb. 2:9; 1 Peter 2:24; 1 Peter 3:18; 2 Peter 3:9; 1 John 2:2).

12. We believe in the bodily resurrection and ascension of Christ and the bodily resurrection of His saints (Matt. 28:1-7; Acts 1:9-11; 1 Cor. 15:42-58; 1 Thess. 4:13-18).

13. We believe in the premillennial, personal, bodily return of Christ as the crowning event of the Gentile age. This event will include the resurrection of the righteous to eternal heaven, and the Millennium will be followed by the resurrection of the unrighteous unto eternal punishment in the lake of fire and that the righteous shall enter into the heaven age (John 14:1-6; 1 Thess. 4:13-18; 2 Thess. 2:8; Rev. 19; Rev. 20:4-6; Rev. 20:11-15; Rev. 21:8).

14. We believe that the depraved sinner is saved wholly by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, and the requisites to regeneration are repentance toward God and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ (Luke 13:3-5; John 3:16-18; Acts 20:21; Rom. 6:23; Eph. 2:8, 9), and that the Holy Spirit convicts sinners, regenerates, seals, secures, and indwells every believer (John 3:6; John 16:8, 9; Rom. 8:9-11; 1 Cor. 6:19, 20; Eph. 4:30; Titus 3:5).

15. We believe that all who trust Jesus Christ for salvation are eternally secure in Him and shall not perish (John 3:36; John 5:24; John 10:27-30; Rom. 8:35-39; Heb. 10:39; 1 Peter 1:5).

16. We believe that God deals with believers as His children, that He chastises the disobedient, and that He rewards the obedient (Matt. 16:27; Matt. 25:14-23; John 1:12; Heb. 12:5-11; 2 John 8; Rev. 22:12).

17. We believe that Jesus Christ established His church during His ministry on earth and that it is always a local, visible assembly of scripturally baptized believers in covenant relationship to carry out the Commission of the Lord Jesus Christ, and each church is an independent, self-governing body, and no other ecclesiastical body may exercise authority over it. We believe that Jesus Christ gave the Great Commission to the New Testament churches only, and that He promised the perpetuity of His churches (Matt. 4:18-22; Matt. 16:18; Matt. 28:19, 20; Mark 1:14-20; John 1:35-51; Eph. 3:21).

18. We believe that there are two pictorial ordinances in the Lord's churches: Baptism and the Lord's Supper. Scriptural baptism is the immersion of penitent believers in water, administered by the authority of a New Testament church in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Lord's Supper is a memorial ordinance, restricted to the members of the church observing the ordinance (Matt. 28:19, 20; Acts 8:12, 38; Rom. 6:4; 1 Cor. 5:11-13; 1 Cor. 11:1, 2, 17-20, 26).

19. We believe that there are two divinely appointed offices in a church, pastors and deacons, to be filled by men whose qualifications are set forth in Titus and 1 Timothy.

Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute **Entrance Requirements**

The Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute is a religious educational institution that is a ministry of a local Baptist Church in the United States. Comparable to a vocational or technical institute of learning, the degrees and certificates offered by UBBI are not to be in replacement of a secular accredited college, but rather for the advancement of Biblical knowledge for all who apply.

Because of the status of the availability of education in the nation of Thailand, UBBI realizes that very few adults in the Northeastern region of Thailand have a high school diploma.

Therefore, as laid out in this college catalog, the entrance requirements for the Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute will be as follows:

1. Profession of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as the only Lord and Savior.
2. Baptized member of a scriptural, local (Baptist) church in good standing.
3. Completion of the Basic Bible Course by Ray McAllister. There will be three (3) credit hours applied to your program of study for the completion of this course.

Course Description: Bible

Bi001 Basic Bible Course

Certificate program course required to enter into any program in the college. Curriculum will consist of Dr. Raymond McAllister's *Basic Bible Booklet* translated into the Thai language.

Bi101 Bible Analysis

Basic course on how to properly study the scriptures, whether topically or exegetically. Student will use a translated copy of Albert Garner's Bible Analysis.

Bi102 Christian Doctrine

A brief look at the Bible as a whole with emphasis on the major doctrines of the Word of God. Curriculum will consist of Garner's *Defense of the Faith*.

Bi103 Old Testament Survey

This course is a synopsis of the Old Testament, book by book, including history, theology, geography, development, and major OT themes.

Bi104 New Testament Survey

This course is a synopsis of the New Testament, book by book. Major NT themes discussed including history, characters, doctrines, geography and life application of NT truths.

Bi201 Synoptic Gospels

A study of Matthew, Mark and Luke as they discuss the life and ministry of Jesus Christ. Comparing and contrasting the three separate but contiguous accounts.

Bi202 John

A verse by verse look at the book of John, discussing the last few weeks in the life of Christ before the Crucifixion, with doctrinal and life application implications.

Bi203 Romans

An exegetical analysis of the epistle of Paul to the Romans and the many major doctrines found therein.

Bi204 Hebrews / Leviticus

A study of the book of Hebrews and Leviticus as the old and new covenants are compared and contrasted.

Bi205 General Epistles

This course is a basic overview of the general, non-Pauline epistles in the New Testament, with their doctrinal implications and practical applications.

Bi301 Pentateuch

A study of the first five books of the Old Testament, from Genesis to Deuteronomy. This overview will be a synopsis of the main characters and history from Adam to Moses and the giving of the law.

Bi302 History Books

Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute

This course is an overview of the books from Joshua to Esther with emphasis on background, character studies and spiritual implications.

Bi303 Poetic Books

A study of the poetic books of the Old Testament from Job to the Song of Solomon.

Bi304 Epistles of Paul

A fundamental study in the Pauline epistles, including background, structure, doctrine, application as well as exegetical analysis of each book.

Bi305 Acts of the Apostles

An exegetical study of the book of Acts as it relates to the spreading of the gospel in the early church age. Emphasis is given on the life of Paul, and the student will have a basic knowledge of contents, doctrine and application of the book.

Bi401 Major Prophets

A study of the books of Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, and Ezekiel, with background studies of how the books relate to the nation of Israel through past pronouncements of judgments and future prophecies.

Bi402 Minor Prophets

This course is a historical overview of the books of Amos through Malachi and how the messages of each book relate to the nation of Israel.

Bi403 Bible Geography and Customs

A study of the manners, customs, and geography of the Bible lands and cultures and how they relate to the Biblical accounts to give the student a well rounded view of the world during Bible times.

Theology

Th101 Theology I

Beginning course in theological studies with focus on Bibliology, Theology, Christology and Pneumatology.

Th201 Theology II

Continuing studies in systematic theology, including Anthropology, Hermatology, and Soteriology.

Th202 Comparative Theology

A look at different world views of theology throughout denominations and religions to determine truth versus error in the light of God's Word.

Th203 Daniel/Revelation

A look at the apocalyptic literature of Daniel and Revelation to gain insight into end time events.

Th301 Theology III

Intermediate studies in the field of Biblical theology including Ecclesiology, Angelology, Demonology, and Eschatology.

Th401 Theology IV

This course will cover theological apologetics and answers to the world's view of God's Word. It will also cover arguments such as covenant vs. dispensational theology and Calvinistic vs. Armenian theology.

Th302 Creation and Evolution

This course covers basic Earth science in light of the Bible and offers various scriptural and scientific arguments against the theory of Darwinism as refuted by Creationism.

Music

Mu101 Music Theory

A study of the fundamentals of music including nomenclature, notation, key signatures, major and minor scales, rhythm, and basic sight reading as related to church music.

Mu102 Basic Piano

A basic introduction and technique to playing the piano or keyboard. The student will gain a basic musical foundation in theory and be able to play simple songs.

Mu103 Basic Guitar

A basic introduction to playing the guitar. The student will gain a basic musical foundation in theory and be able to play several chords, scales, learn strumming techniques and some basic 4-5 chord pieces.

Mu202 Intermediate Piano I

A study of intermediate keyboard techniques. Emphasis on scales, chords, and playing simple hymns. Prerequisite: Mu102

Mu203 Intermediate Guitar I

A study of intermediate guitar techniques such as improving music reading and playing chords in various keys. Prerequisite: Mu103

Mu302 Intermediate Piano II

A continuation of intermediate one-on-one piano instruction. Prerequisite: Mu203

Mu303 Intermediate Guitar II

A continuation of individual, intermediate guitar techniques. Prerequisite: Mu203

Mu402 Advanced Piano

Studies for the advanced pianist focusing on more difficult scales, improvisation, and classical musical pieces to further improve the skill of the pianist.

Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute

Mu403 Advanced Guitar

For the advanced guitarist, Mu403 will focus on solo and melody guitar techniques, arpeggio picking and difficult classical guitar pieces. Prerequisite: Mu303

Mu104 Choir Ensemble

A four part harmony choir of both men and women designed to improve vocal quality and harmony while singing church music in a church setting.

Mu201 Choir and Song

Leading

A study of basic conducting techniques as they relate to choir, ensemble, and congregational song leading. Some basic music theory will be presented to the student as relating to conducting vocal and instrumental music.

Pastoral Arts

Pa101 Homiletics

A course on sermon preparation, exegesis, outlining, topic study, and delivery with focus on sermon planning and effective presentation.

Pa102 Personal Evangelism

A course in evangelism techniques to encourage the student to reach others for Christ and embolden his zeal for spreading the gospel. Will include instruction and practice

and the student will be required to participate in evangelistic exercises.

Pa201 Church

Administration

Church administration is for pastors or for those who are aspiring to be pastors. Discusses the conduct, lifestyle, responsibilities and duties of a pastor.

Pa202 Church History

This course deals with the history of the Baptists and others who held to the same basic beliefs throughout the ages, from the ministry of Jesus Christ to the present day, as true Christianity has spread throughout the world.

Pa203 Missiology

A basic course in Christian missions outlining the biblical foundation, aspects of mission work, and biblical pattern for missions. Emphasis will be focused on church planting and techniques, with real life practicum.

Pa301 Ministerial Practicalities

Included in this course will be ministerial practicalities such as weddings, funerals and church discipline, as well as Sunday school administration and basic functions that relate to the day to day organization and direction of the church.

Pa302 Sunday School

Administration

A basic course on starting and properly conducting a Sunday school. Techniques on how to make your

church grow and delegate responsibility while using church members in ministry.

Pa401 Biblical Counseling

This course includes studies in basic psychological principles and counseling techniques from the viewpoint of God's Word in a ministerial setting.

Languages

La101 Elementary English

An introduction to the English language for Thai students with little or no previous foundation in English language skills.

La102 English I

This course is for those who already have a basic foundation in English. Vocabulary and conversation is emphasized. Prerequisite: Basic English Exam.

La202 English II

Reading and writing in the English language is the focus of this course with exercises in intermediate conversation skills.

La302 English III

This course will deal with grammar, idioms, advanced speaking, reading, listening and comprehension skills.

La402 English IV

This course is for the advanced English speaker as a second language. Focus will be on vocal accent, vocabulary building, speech and writing skills.

La201 Basic Greek

An introduction to the Greek language as applied to the study of the New Testament. Basic reading, writing, grammar and vocabulary skills are emphasized.

La202 Basic Hebrew

An introduction to the Hebrew language as it related to the Old Testament scriptures. Reading, grammar and basic vocabulary are emphasized.

La301 Intermediate Greek

A continuation of exercises in the Greek language intended to help the student further his studies in the New Testament. Grammar and vocabulary skills will be strengthened along with some translation of Bible passages. Prerequisite: BL201

La302 Intermediate Hebrew

A continuation of exercises in the Hebrew language intended to help the student further his studies in the Old Testament. Grammar and vocabulary skills will be strengthened along with some translation of Bible passages. Prerequisite: BL202

La401 Advanced Greek Lab

An advanced study of the Greek language. The student will be required to translate large passages from the New Testament and apply his study to reinforce his Biblical stand. A 5000 word paper using research from Greek language studies will be required. Prerequisite: BL301

La402 Advanced Hebrew Lab

An advanced study of the Hebrew language. The student will be required to translate large passages from the Old Testament and apply his study to reinforce his Biblical stand. A 5000 word paper using research from Hebrew language studies will be required. Prerequisite: BL302

Courses Offered by Seminar

Many courses during the course of the school year may be offered by seminar as qualified teachers and professors in their fields of study visit to expound their knowledge on a subject that could not otherwise be offered through the institute. As such, these seminars may last as little as one to two weeks in length, yet cover an extensive amount of information. Because of this, all students attending a seminar for class credit will be required to attend at least 90% of the time to receive credit for the seminar. All work must be turned in on time and a grade point of 3.0 or better will be required for credit.

Grading Scale

Udon Baptist Bible Institute grades on a four point grading scale for all final grades in class. Because of the religious nature and ministerial application of the courses taught at UBBI, a grade point average of less than 2.0 will not be given credit towards a program of study, and an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher is required to graduate. The following scale is as follows:

- 0.0 – F (Failing)
- 1.0 – D (Below Average)
- 2.0 – C (Average)
- 3.0 – B (Above Average)
- 4.0 – A (Excellent)

A student may be eligible for academic honors by achieving a GPA of 3.25 or higher per semester, with which he would be placed on the Dean's list. An overall GPA of 3.25 or higher would qualify the student to graduate *Cum Laude*. A semester average of 4.0 would be recognized on the President's list, and a graduating GPA of 4.0 would qualify the student to graduate with highest honors, *Magna Cum Laude*.

Code of Conduct

All students of the Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute are expected to submit to a code of conduct as becoming a servant of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Each student must submit to the doctrinal statement and give due respect to the teacher or professor of each class. Dress code will include shirts and ties with dress slacks for men and dresses or skirts and blouses for women no shorter than knee length. Specific offenses will not be listed here, but if it becomes known of any conduct unbecoming of a Christian by one of the students enrolled at UBBI, disciplinary action will be taken which may include expulsion.

Finances and Fees

The Udon Thani Baptist Bible Institute is offered as a ministry of Thailand Missions of the Westwood Missionary Baptist Church of Winter Haven, FL. USA. Therefore, in light of the financial situation of the vast majority of students who will be attending the school, all courses will be offered free of charge. Of course, there are many expenses in the running of a school including but not limited to utilities, text translation and printing, and special speakers. Any gifts or contributions to the school are greatly appreciated.
